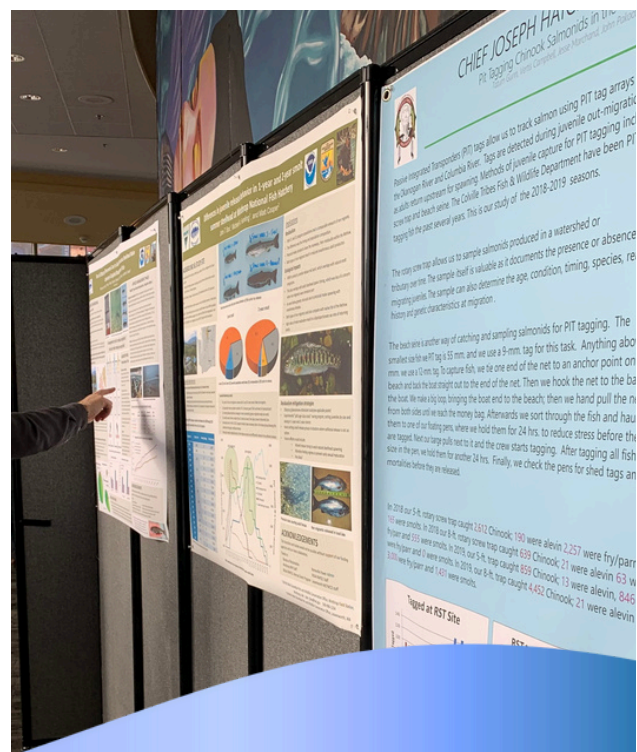
ABOUT THE EVENT
